Fathers Day

**Father's Day** is celebrated on the third Sunday in June each year, and is the day you celebrate fathers and fatherhood, paternal bonds, and the influence of fathers in society.





**Father's Day** Father's Day was invented by American Mrs. Sonora Smart Dodd whose father had, as a single parent raised his six children. The first Father's Day was celebrated on June 19, 1910.

**Father's Day** in China used to be celebrated on 8th August. The reason is a linguistic one; the Chinese for eight is "ba", while a colloquial word for father is "ba-ba" – therefore the eighth day of the eighth month sounds similar to "papa".



My boy was just like me


